

Catch My Fall

This filet crochet scarf is based on a 4 x 3 grid: each square is 4 double crochets wide and 3 chains high. The design was improvised, and therefore, very simple. The scarf was made as a donation to one of the El Segundo Slipt Stitcher's charities.

Materials

- 1 skein Red Heart Boutique Unforgettable (Pictured Colorway: Tidal)
- US H/8 5.0 mm Crochet Hook
- · Tapestry Needle

Legend

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

sp = space

Recipe

Foundation Ch 28 + 3

Row 1: Dc in fourth chain from hook and across, ch 3, turn. (28 dc)

Row 2: 3 Dc, [ch 2, dc in dc] 7 times, 4 dc, ch 3, turn.

Row 3: 3 Dc, ch 2, dc in dc, 2 dc in ch 2 sp, [dc in dc, ch 2] 3 times, dc in dc, 2 dc in ch 2 sp, dc in dc, ch 2, 4 dc, ch 3, turn.

Row 4: 3 Dc [ch2, dc in dc] 2 times, 2 dc in ch 2 sp, dc in dc, ch 2, dc in dc, 2 dc in ch 2 sp, [dc in dc, ch 2] 2 times, 4 dc, ch 3, turn.

Row 5: 3 Dc, [ch 2, dc in dc] 3 times, 2 dc in ch 2 sp, [dc in dc, ch 2] 3 times, 4 dc, ch 3 turn.

Row 6-116: Repeat rows three through five 37 times more.

Row 117: 3 Dc, [ch 2, dc in dc] 7 times, 4 dc, ch 3, turn.

Row 118: Dc across.

Finishing

Weave in ends.
