The Knitting Tree

This tapestry crochet pillow uses only two colors for ease of construction and color-changing. Unlike me, ensure your color choices share the same yarn weight.

The pillow is constructed in single crochet and each row is worked from right to left.

Materials

- 2 skeins Cascade 220 Heathers (9599 Savanna) and 1 skein Cascade 220 Heathers (2441 River Rock) or 2 skeins Universal Deluxe Superwash (710 Greenery) and 1 skein Universal Deluxe Superwash (728 Pulp)
- 12-inch Pillow Form
- Tapestry Needle
- Snippers

Changing Colors

The best way to change colors is to finish the last Yarn A single crochet with Yarn B, and vice versa, as illustrated. You may choose to carry your yarn underneath your stitches or strand behind your work.



Finishing

I like to seam three sides using single crochet. After three sides are done, I insert the pillow form and seam up the final side.
