



Night And Day by Hooker Leo

One of my favorite songs is *Night And Day*, by Cole Porter, performed by U2 from the album Red, Hot +Blue: A Tribute to Cole Porter. I finally was able to obtain the song for my own listening pleasure and decided to create this scarf as homage.

This filet crochet pattern is based on a 3x3 grid, not your normal 4 x 3 grid, so that every square represents 3 double crochet versus 4.

Materials

- 2 Skeins Universal Deluxe Worsted Superwash (Marigold & Twilight)
- US H/8 5.0 mm Crochet Hook
- Tapestry Needle
- Snippers

Finished Size

6 X 79 inches (excluding fringe)

Legend

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

Instructions

Ch 31 + 3 (counts as dc).

Row 1: Dc in fifth chain from hook and across (31 dc). Ch 3, turn at the end of every row.

Follow chart on following page, remembering that each vertical line is a dc; filled squares are filled with 1 dc; empty squares are filled with 1 ch.


Motes

Reminder: after turning, your first dc will be in the second st of each row, as the ch 3 counts as a dc and occupies the first st of each row.

Each row measures .25 inches. For a shorter scarf, start by crocheting only two grid rows after the emblem versus the charted eight rows. This should shorten the scarf by 12 rows, equaling 3 inches. Next adjustments should start with the larger rows of grid first.

Example: replacing the 10 rows with 9 and following the decrease would shave of another 5 inches.

In essence, your chart would go from...



1/10/2/9/3/8/4/7/5/6/6/5/7/4/8/3/9/2/10/1

to

1/9/2/8/3/7/4/6/5/5/6/4/7/3/8/2/9/1

and so on...
